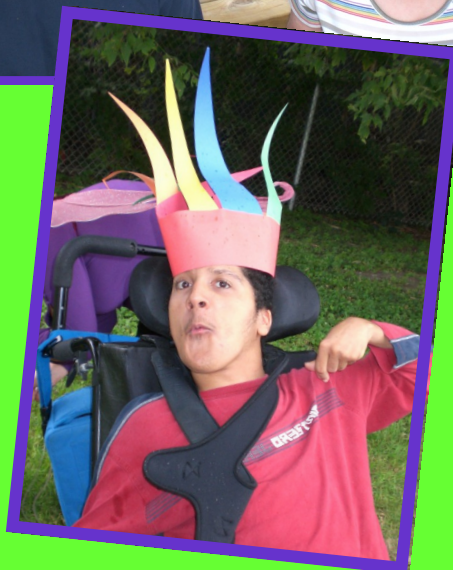

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Where is the program?** The program runs out of 361 Montreal Street Monday through Thursday, and on Fridays meets at St. Lawrence College and joins in activities with our Integrated Summer Camp.

**How well trained are your staff?** Many of our staff have graduated from College with an Autism Behavioural Science, Social Worker, Child and Youth Worker, or Early Childhood Education diploma. Some of our staff work as teachers and Educational Assistants in the Public and Catholic School Boards during the school year. Staff are trained in first aid and CPR, Crisis Intervention, Behaviour Management, seizure protocols, emergency procedures, lifts, transfers, personal care, and roles and responsibilities.

**If an adult doesn't attend on a given day because he or she is ill, is there a refund of fees paid?** No. We do not refund fees for days missed. If an adult does not attend on a particular day, we still have to pay for staff and expenses. Please note that no refunds will be issued if a registration is cancelled within 2 weeks of a session. If adequate notice is received, refunds will be issued within 30 days subject to a \$75 cancellation fee. Exceptions may be made in extenuating circumstances and at the discretion of the Executive Director.

**What is the cut-off date for registration?** The deadline for registration for this program is May 15. Registrations will be considered after that date if there is space available.

**When will I know that registration is confirmed?** Registration will be confirmed when we have received full payment, or payment arrangements have been made with EAF. **Fees must be paid in full, or arrangements made by June 1.** Consideration will be given to late registrants if space is available.

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
